Work with community to identify areas where public seating and a BBQ can be sited	Community/ Council	We will arrange a meeting with community to see what areas they are looking at – Works Department will then arrange a meeting with TasNetworks for them to assess the viability and practicability of the areas identified. <u>October, 2024 Update -</u> The proposal for further additional public facilities was explored in consultation with the Ansons Bay Progress Committee who confirmed the lack of support for a public BBQ on currently owned Council land. No other potential sites have been identified we will revisit this with the new committee.
