Develop scope works to undertake reseal and deformation corrections of Alexander Street – external funding will be required – listed in 4 year capital plan	Council	Council has secured funding under the Australian Governments Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program – Phase 4 to progress the rehabilitation of Alexander Street, Cornwall. The project scope includes the rehabilitation of carriageway over a distance of 1,120m that includes the road shoulders and supporting roadside stormwater drainage. The LRCIP contribution is \$215,000 with Council to contribute \$85,000 in the 2024-2025 capital budget.
